RESOLUTION M160 -12102007 MIDDLEWEIGHT ELIMINATION FIGHT WBA CHAMPIONSHIPS COMMITTEE MIDDLEWEIGHT DIVISION

1. Application.

The WBA Championships Committee gathered in the city of Chengdu, China on October 07- 13, 2007, decided to grant the approval to a fight between Mariano Carrera and Javier Castillejo on November 13, 2007 in Baden-Württemberg, Germany as elimination bout to determine the next Official Challenger of the division.

2. Background.

1. The WBA Middleweight World Champion, Felix Sturm will make the next mandatory defense of his title against the Official Challenger of the division, Randy Griffin, on October 20, 2007 in Westphalia, Germany.

2. The next mandatory defense of the World Boxing Association Middleweight Champion (Sturm or Griffin) should be no later than July 20, 2008.

3. Mariano Carrera (No. 2) and Javier Castillejo (No. 3) are the leading available rated contenders in the Middleweight Division, according to the WBA August 2007 ratings.

4. Articles 29, 30 and 31 of the Championship Rules state that the Championships Committee may order elimination bouts or Box-Off to determine the Official Challenger of any division.

3. Decision

a. The WBA Championships Committee unanimously decided,

b. To order the elimination bout between the No. 2 Contender, Mariano Carrera, and No. 3 Javier Castillejo to determine the next Official Challenger of the Middleweight Division of the WBA.

c. The elimination fight between Mariano Carrera and Javier Castillejo will take place on November 13, 2007 in Germany.

4. Appeal

This Resolution may be appealed pursuant to New Rule F, Appeals and Requests for

Reconsideration. Copies of the Rule may be provided upon request.
